March 11, 1968

Mrs. Probe called at the office to get clothing for her family. She will try to attend the Tuesday might meeting. I called on Mayor, Adrian Mischelberger and invited him to attend the Nednesday afternoon luncheon at Kelly's Restaurant in Beaverton. He will talk on Sherwood area at the court house meeting. I called on Jin Farrott, president of JC's and discussed youth club, and projects planned for the city park. I called Marjorie Stewart to compile data on Sherwood resources for the Wednesday meeting. I supervised tutoring classin evening and attended swim club meeting.

March 12, 1968

I made phone calls and planned meeting for this evening. I had a consultation with Gretchen also t NYC help. I helped Mrs. Prebe with some clothing.

I attended the meeting in the evening at Washington County Court house.

March 13, 1968

I talked with Bete about the meeting, then called Rev. Harden and made appointment for Pete. I talked to Irs. Webb and she doesn's need a ride to Hillsboro. I weat to luncheen in Beaverton with Mayor Eickenburger and discussed Sherwoods problems. I made an appointment with welfare for Hrs. Bergland, and counseled Mrs. Bergland and her mother, Mrs. Snead. Both signed up for tutoring class beginning next Monday afternoon. I talked to Mrs. Mikan about MDTA and called counselor, Mrs. Campbell.
