"My love of gardening came very late to me. After leaving the house I shared with my sister for 17 years, my health began to run away from me and my overactive mind did not have room for flowers. After several hospital stays (for broken ribs and pelvis), my mind was as jumbled and broken as my bones. I moved to a half-way house and eventually made my way home to The Watershed. From my third-story apartment I can walk to the roof-top garden. Last year my sister brought tomato plants, a corn stalk, sunflower and marigolds. But this year, I put all my heart into it and did as much of the work as I could. I am so proud to see my planter boxes all in a row. I am so grateful to have the chances I have gotten and the friends I have made here at The Watershed, where I hope to spend the rest of my life."
