COUNTY COUNSEL, WASHINGTON COUNTY HILLSBORO, OREGON

(A) HORNS, SIGNALING DEVICES, ETC.

The sound of any horn or signaling device on any automobile, motorcycle or other vehicle on any street or public place of the county, except as a danger warning; the creation by means of any such signaling device of any unreasonably loud or harsh sound; and the sounding of any such device for an unnecessary and unreasonable period of time. The use of any signaling device except one operated by hand or electricity; the use of any horn, whistle or other device operated by engine exhaust; and the use of any such signaling device when traffic is for any reason held up.

(B) RADIOS, PHONOGRAPHS, ETC.

The using, operating, or permitting to be played, used or operated any radio receiving set, musical instrument, phonograph, or other machine or device for the producing or reproducing of sound in such manner as to disturb the peace, quiet and comfort of the neighboring inhabitants or at any time with louder volume than is necessary for convenient hearing for the person or persons within the room, vehicle or chamber in which such machine or device is operated, and who are voluntary listeners thereto. The operation of any such set, instrument, phonograph, machine or device between the hours of eleven o'clock p.m. and seven o'clock a.m. in such a manner as to be plainly audible at a distance of 100 feet from the building, structure or vehicle in which it is located shall be PRIMA FACIE evidence of a violation of this section.

(C) <u>LOUDSPEAKERS AND AMPLIFIERS</u>. The using, operating or permitting to be played, used or operated, of any

machine or device for the producing or reproducing of sound which is cast upon or over the public streets for the purpose of commercial advertising, or used in the conducting of a commercial enterprise or attracting the attention of the public to any building or structure or activity thereon.

(D) <u>YELLING AND SHOUTING</u>. Yelling, shouting, hooting, whistling, or singing on the public streets, particularly between the hours of 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. or at any time or place so as to annoy or disturb the quiet, comfort, or repose of persons in any office, or in any dwelling, or other type of residence, or of any persons in the vicinity.

(E) <u>ANIMALS AND BIRDS</u>. The keeping of any animal or bird which, by causing long and continued noise shall disturb the comfort or repose of any persons in the vicinity.

(F) <u>SCHOOLS, COURTS, CHURCHES, HOSPITALS</u>. The creation of any excessive noise on any street adjacent to any school, institution oflearning or church while the same are in use, or adjacent to any hospital, which unreasonably interferes with the workings of such institution, or which disturbs or unduly annoys patients in the hospital, provided conspicuous signs are displayed in such streets indicating that the same is a school or hospital.

27 SECTION IV -- PENALTIES.

Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a county offense and upon conviction thereof shall be fined a sum not exceeding \$_____ or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than _____ days, or by both such said fine and said imprisonment.
