Dear Les:

Congratulations on your reelection to the United States House of Representatives. We engaged in a long, hard fought campaign and I sincerely hope you will responsibly represent our district in Congress.

Frankly, I was pleased with positions you took during the campaign, and hope we will see you follow through on the commitments you've made.

I was particularly pleased to hear you say on KXL a week ago that you oppose increased taxes. Your opposition to tax increases is needed in Congress, and I hope we can count on you to stand by your position.

It is also very important to the people of our district that you follow through on your pledge to reduce federal spending -- and that you stand up to Tip O'Neill, and truly be an "independent democrat" as you've said.
