Every entry where a person's name is given has been included, plus each entry that indicates a new or unusual event.

- Jan. 1 Went to the east plain for a letter that came from the States.
 - Sab. 2 Tended meeting at the shanty
 - 3. Did chores about home & loaned a horse to Wm. Stokes to go on an expedition against the Cayuse Indians for murdering Doc Whitman
 - 4 Did chores about home & loaned Alvin Brown a rifle for the same purpose as Wm. Stokes a horse
 - 6 Butchered hogs, John Buts (Butts?) helpt me & I sold him 314 lbs at 4 cts per lb.
 - 7 Helpt dig the grave for & tended the burial of Mr. Thompsons child
 - 11 Went up to the Tualatin lodge to see Hady (?) Rowlands children as they are orphaned
 - 12 Went to Newbanks & Naylors to see if they would take some of the children but they did not agree to
 - 15 Went to the east plain to tend a meeting of the citizens to organize into a military capacity for defence against the Indians in case of disturbance
- Sab 16 Tended meeting at the shanty
 - 17 Tended a sale on the east plain
 - 18 Cut & halled up wood to the door & let Wm. Beagle have my fine horse to go on an expedition against the Cayuse Indians the same as my other horse
 - 19 Went to the Falls to Mr. Spaldings & wife & hear more particular of the murder
 - 20 Staid at the Falls
 - 21 Came home from the Falls
 - 24 Halled some wood to the school house & tended a military meeting
 - 25 Worked at my new pasture fence
 - 26 Worked about home & made some fence & mr. Carle commenced getting out timber
 - 27 Halled up logs for the Orphan asylum
 - 29 Tended a military meeting & a prayer meeting
 - 31 Did chores & got Dickson to mend my shoes
- Feb. 1 Worked at my pasture fence
 - 2 Halled some rails for my orchard
 - 3 Worked some at my orchard fence

- Feb. 7 Got Messrs Catching & Pomeroys oxen to go to the falls for Mr. Spalding & his family
 - 8 Start to the Falls & went to the buter (? word faded)
 - 9 Went to the falls & loaded up the things
 - 10 Came out to A.J.Masters
 - 11 Came home with half of Mr. Spaldings things
 - 16 Killed 2 hogs & sold one to John Sylvester
 - 22 Went to Br. Geigers & back home & visited with Messrs Clark, Spalding & Geiger families
 - 23 Went to Mr. Holmans with my wife & made a pair of bars for for my sheep yard
 - 24 Worked with my team for the Orphan asylum
 - 25 Worked some at my orchard fence
- Sab 27 Tended meeting. Br. Spalding preached
 - 28 Worked some at my orchard fence & Mr. Davis begins to plow for wheat
- Mar. 3 Made a settlement with Mr. Gale for everything except boarding his children, Edward & Susan, & he owes me 66 10/100 dolls
 - 4 Worked at my orchard fence & Mr. Davis sowed 17 3/4 bushels red wheat
 - 7 Worked at my orchard fence & Eli Harper came to work a month at 200 lbs of fresh prok per month
 - 8 Worked up on the asylum
 - 10 Worked at my orchard fence. Eli helpt Mr. Brown
 - 11 Finished my orchard fence
 - 13 Worked about the old house garden
 - 16 Worked on the Orphan asylum
 - 20 Plowed some in my orchard & sent a kid skin to Mr. Wilks by his son & put up 4 hogs to fat
 - 22 Hunted hogs & cattle & did chores
 - 24 Halled stakes & did chores & worked on the asylum
- Sab. 26 Tended meeting at the meeting house for the first time
- Apr. 1 Did chores & tended lecture preparatory to communion
- Sab 2 Tended meeting & had a communion service
 - 3 Got out maneur & tended monthly concert (Note: first time this recorded)
 - 5 Went to Mr. Wilks to see about my leather
 - 6 Did chores about home & got my face burned
 - 10 Cut some of my bulls & did chores
 - 12 Went to Portland on the Wallamette river
 - 13 Went to Vancouver, traded some & back to Portland
 - 14 Came home from Portland
 - 15 Did chores at home & wrote some to Caleb

- April 17 Helpt Messrs Shuey & Shepherd to start. Sent a letter to Caleb & a horse worth 60 dollars in cash by Mr. John Shuey & a letter to Connecticut to our friends there
 - 18 Hunted for a cow & calf but did not find them. Mr. Davis planted potatoes
 - 19 Hunted my cow & calf. Davis sowed
 - 20 Went to mill for self & Mr. Spalding.
 - 21 Did chores & killed 2 hogs & paid off Eli Harper & let Mr. Spalding have 290 lbs of fresh pork
 - 24 Loaned Mr. Gale 200. for milk (?)

May

- 3 Worked in my garden & sowed onions & bought a ram of Mr. Patton for 8 dolls & John Terwilliger came here to board & go to school & work for his board
- 4 Went to mill & borrowed 4.6 lbs of flour, bag & all, of Hinmoons & did chores
- 5 Worked in my garden & paid off Mr. Clark for the books I bought of him
- 6 Worked in my garden & surveyed the grounds for the meeting house
- 9 Worked in my garden & bought a quilt of Mr. Giprson (?) for 100 lbs of fresh prok
- 10 Went to mill & got the grist that I took there for Mr. Spalding
- 11 Hunted & altered my bull & did chores
- 16 Went to Mr. Gales & got the steelyards & to Mr. Spaldings & got some sugar & syrup & killed hogs & delivered to Mr. Johnson 200 lbs of fresh pork for Alanson Hinman
- 17 Salted my pork & planted yard
- 20 Sowed some beans & peas
- 22 Sheared a part of my sheep
- 27 Planted some corn & plowed my old garden

June (June 3 to 20 too faded to read)

- 21 Went to Portland
- 22 Did my trading & came home
- 23 Did chores about home & pulled thistles out of my wheat
- 24 Repaired my yard fence & tended prayer meeting
- Sab. 25 Tended meeting Br. Clark preached
 - 26 Worked on the camp ground
 - 27 Butchered a beef for the camp meeting & did chores about home
 - 28 Moved my family to the camp ground & tended the meeting
 - 29-30-July 1-2 Tended the meeting

- July 3 Broke up the meeting & came home
 - 4 Went up to Mr. Dixons & did chores
 - 6 Got some timber for a cheese press & halled a load of rails
 - 10-11-12-13 Worked at my cheese press
 - 18 Went to the blacksmiths shop & back home
 - 21 Worked at my cheese press & repaired my trucks
 - 26 Went to the Wallamette Falls to attend a meeting of the Board of the tract society
 - 27 Came home
 - 28 Worked some at my cheese press
- Aug. 1 Helpt Mr. Snowden (2) about finishing surveying my claim
 - 3 Finished surveying my claim & established NE corner
 - 7 Went to Portland & back
 - 10 Got Mr. Clarks trucks & repairing them for halling timber
 - 16+ Halling in wheat
 - 21 Worked at the old house & fixed it for storing my wheat
 - 24 Got in 116 bu wheat & went to Mr. Benj Catchings & paid him off
 - 28 Went to Mr. Lenox with Mr. Spalding to get John Himseys (?) deposition respecting that the Roman Catholics were determine to have Dr. Whitmans station
- Sept. 2 Went over to the East Plain to attend a farmers meeting
 - 6 Went to Portland with Calvin
 - 7 Came back with Calvin B. Green & his mother wishes me to keep him until she returns from California next Spring & she says that she will settle for his staying with us but if she never comes back she wishes us to keep him as our own.
 - 9-11 Halling in wheat
 - 11 Mr. Gale sent his children here to stay until he returns from California
 - 21 Went to Mr. Buxtons with my wife
 - 26 Went to Portland & back
 - 28 Went to Portland with my butter
 - 29 Did not sell my butter & started home & camped in the woods
 - Oct. 5 Worked at home at my chamber floor
 - 6 Halled in squashes
 - 9 Started for Vancouver & went to Logies
 - 10 Went to the fort & traded & back to Logies

- Oct. 17 Began to frame my corn shed
 - 18 Halled in corn
 - 19 Halled in oats
 - 21 Had a meeting to alter the burying ground & tended the funeral of Mr. Ben Catchings oldest son
 - 25 Went to Messrs Spalding, A. Smith, O. Brown, Gales, Mills & home
 - 31 Went to Mr. Wilks & got some leather
- Nov. 3 Commenced plowing for wheat (Note:first time Fall plowing)
 (Plowed most of the days in November)
 - 22 Butchered my hogs
 - 23 Salted my pork
 - 24 Went to Mr. Wilks with a beef hide & 2 calf skins & got some leather
 - 30 Went to the meeting of the trustees of our academy to see about locating it
- Dec. 1-2 Did the same
 - 9 Wrote a contract between Charles Conklin & Alvin C. Brown & tended church meeting
 - 12 Tended to locating the academy
 - 13 Went to see Mr. Butts about putting up the frame of the academy
- Sab 31 Tended meeting. Thus endeth another year
- 1849
- Jan. 1 Went up to Mr. Dawsons & up on the Yam hill to see about the cattle belonging to Margaret & Catherine
 - 2 Came home from Mr. Dawsons
 - 3 Went to Mr. Spaldings with Mrs. Smith & then went to Mr. Harpers to consult him respecting Eli & he retains his wages which is 6 months & 17 days work
 - 4 Went to the mill & had a talk with Mr. Allen respecting his & Gales affairs
 - Went to the probate judge G.H.Coffinburg with Mr. Wm. Dawson & he as agent of the guardian of Robert Owens children got an order from the judge for the cattle belonging to the said Owens estate & the said Dawson received the cattle being 18 in number & brought them to my house, the cattle being 4 old cows with 2 male & 2 female calves, 3 two yr old heifers, one with a young bull calf, two steers & 2 (?)
