JOINT ASSEMBLY IN THE HOUSE

(In the Senate)

President:

in second

"The desk staff and members of the Senate will assemble in the center aisle and be assisted by the Sergeant at Arms to form a column of two's with the Senate staff leading and followed by the Senators -the President last."

Order for formation is:

1. Sgt. at Arms and Secretary of Senate

- 2. Desk staff
- 3. Senators -- the President last

Sgt. at Arms and Secretary of Senate lead the column to the House. Column halts as it arrives at the center entrance of the House. The center doors may or may not be open. If not open, the Senate Sgt. at Arms raps on the door. After doors are opened by House Sgt. at Arms, the Senate Sgt. at Arms announces arrival of Senate.

(In the House)

House Sgt. at Arms will be at the center doors facing the Senate; he turns about and addresses the Speaker:

House Sgt at Arms "Mr. Speaker, I have the honor to announce that the Senate has arrived."

Speaker: "The Serg

"The Sergeant at Arms will admit the members of the Senate and staff." House Sgt. at Arms stands aside by the center doors and the Secretary of the Senate, Senate Sgt. at Arms, Staff, and Senators proceed down the center aisle in a column of two's. They halt near the midway point, turn to face each other providing a passage way between the column of two's. (President is at the end of the line.)

Speaker:

"The Sergeant at Arms of the House will escort the President of the Senate to the Rostrum."

(President of the Senate is escorted to the steps of the Rostrum where he is greeted by the Speaker, escorted to the Rostrum and tendered the gavel. The column remains in place until the President of the Senate presides.

The President then presides.

President:

"The Sergeant at Arms of the Senate will seat the Senators."

The Senate Sgt. at Arms proceeds to a point in front of the Rostrum, faces the column of Senators and directs them to left and right. The Senators, starting with the pair at the rear of the column, proceeds down the center aisle, followed successively by pairs with the right column turning right and the left column turning left. (Chairs are provided for Senators in front of the first row of House members' desks.)

Senate Sgt. at Arms then takes a position at the desk of the House Sgt. at Arms.

President:

(1 gavel for all to be seated.)

President: "The Secretary of the Senate will call the roll of the Senate."

(Roll Call)

"The Chief Clerk of the House will call the roll of the House."

(Roll Call)

(RETURNS GAVEL TO THE SPEAKER)

Speaker:

THE SENATE SGT AT ARMS WILL ESCORT THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, MEMBERS OF THE SENATE, AND STAFF FROM THE HOUSE CHAMBER.

THIS JOINT ASSEMBLY IS ADJOURNED. 1 GAVEL
