Shelter Services

It costs \$67 to shelter a person for one night.

That cost includes:

- Safe, secure, temporary housing (for up to 5 weeks)
- Individualized case management: assessment, goal setting, linkage to resources, advocacy
- Health classes provided by Washington County Health Department
- Parenting classes
- Food, clothing, transportation and other basic needs assistance

Homeless Children's Program

- Head Start for preschoolers
- Homeless education services in collaboration with Hillsboro School District
- After-school tutoring, homework groups and play groups
- Summer children's activities, including field trips
