

This Indenture Witnesseth, That Jason Wheeler
and Eliza D. Wheeler his wife, for the consideration of the sum
of One DOLLARS,
to them paid, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto Mary F. Waller the following described premises, to-wit:
Lot number five (5) containing Ten and
Six hundredths ($10\frac{6}{100}$) acres as shown
on a plat of Jason Wheeler's home farm
in Linn County, Oregon, and record-
ed in Book of Plots no 2 Page 7 on the
24th day of April 1889 Should the grantee
at any time sell the above described
land, the proceeds shall be re-
vested in the name of the grantee
and her heirs in real estate.



To Have and to Hold the said premises, with their appurtenances, unto the said
Mary F. Walker her heirs and assigns
forever. And we the said Jason Wheeler & Eliza N. Wheeler hereby
covenant to and with the said Mary F. Walker
her heirs and assigns, that I am the owner in fee simple of said premises ; that they
are free from all incumbrances, and that we will warrant and defend the same
from all lawful claims whatsoever.
