Visited with Denny Smith. Several points from him.

- 1. Both he and you need out-front and positive action during these economic times. He feels you and he must work together to bring the Reagan administration's attention to Oregon's plight, even though nothing may be accomplished. He feels Packwood is losing strength and both of you should stay out of "that dogfight."
- 2. Alumax still is committed to Oregon. Denny wants a demonstration of that commitment through Alumax developing a formal plan for entry into our industrial environment. Denny wishes to discuss this further with both of us the week of Thanksgiving.
