

EARLY PIONEER VISITS

WITH CYRUS H. WALKER

A. J. Leach of Oakdale, Nebr., is in Albany today visiting Cyrus H. Walker. The two were fellow-students at Pacific University, Forest Grove from 1855 to 1857.

They had not seen each other since the last named year and had much to talk over. Mr. Leach was one of the pioneer settlers in Nebraska, going there in 1867, taking up a homestead in 1869. Near this sprang up the town of Oakdale, of which he is now a citizen. In those early years game of all kinds was plentiful and he won fame as a hunter. Mr. Leach goes on to Eugene this evening to visit friends there and at Coburg.

He returns home the 14th instant.
