MEDALS WON BY THE JAPANESE AND CHINESE IN THE 1984 OLYMPIC GAMES

Japan won 10 gold medals, eight silver, 14 bronze--for a total of 32. Five of these were in judo; nine were in wrestling.

China won 15 gold medals, eight silver, nine bronze--also for a total of 32 medals. Four of these were in weightlifting, three were in diving and four were in shooting.
