SUBJECT: Geographic Distribution of Executive Appointees Subject to Senate Confirmation

DATE: March 2, 1984

You asked Legislative Research to compare the percent of state population in each county with the percent of executive board and commission appointees from each county. Table 1 provides that information and indicates that 14 counties have a larger percent of appointees than is their percent of total state population, 16 have a smaller percent of appointees than percent of population, and six have the same percent of appointees as population.

A spokeswoman for the governor emphasized that the 472 appointees to the 68 boards and commissions requiring senate confirmation are less than half of total appointments made by the governor.
