

June 28 **No Agent for Warm Springs.** *1900*

A dispatch from Washington yesterday says: After July 1 the office of Indian agent at Warm Springs, Or., will be dispensed with, at which time Agent James L. Cowan will be dropped. The Indian department has decided that there is no real necessity for an agent at Warm Springs, and will place the agency and schools under a bonded superintendent. James E. Kirk, who has been appointed superintendent, will assume charge when his bond is approved, but until then A. O. Wright, supervisor of Indian schools, will be temporarily in charge after July 1.

This will let J. L. Cowan out of a government job.
