

IDEAL LOCATION

Secluded among groves of towering sequoias and white oaks, Pacific University stands deep in the tranquility and pristine beauty of the Tualatin Valley. Close to the heart of the quiet, industrious town of Forest Grove, Pacific University combines all the advantages of a small University with many of those of a larger one, as the metropolis of Portland is but an easy 21 miles away—30 minutes over a smooth modern highway . . . Less than an hour to the west lies the majestic Pacific Ocean, with its broad gleaming beaches. Over a week-end one can leisurely visit and enjoy the beauties of the Cascades, skiing at Mt. Hood, and excursions on the mighty Columbia River. Virtually the playgrounds of the Northwest form the campus of Pacific University.

FACULTY

Limited enrollment at Pacific University allows student and teacher the intimacy of a cultural and scholastic life, otherwise impossible . . . The University's faculty is exceptional. It's members have been drawn from distinguished institutions from all parts of the United States, with several from the leading educational centers of Europe.

HOUSING

Pacific University boasts of two of the most modernly equipped dormitories to be found on any campus. Herrick Hall, with its attractive homelike rooms, affords relaxation and study privileges to the women it houses. Across the campus is McCormick Hall, the men's dormitory, under the direction of the genial assistant coach functions on a co-operative basis . . . In addition, board and room may be secured at reasonable rates in nearby Forest Grove.

STUDY FACILITIES

Of the seven beautiful campus buildings, Marsh Hall dominates as an imposing symbol of the dignity which is the heritage of a century of education. The nearby, handsome Carnegie Library contains 30,000 bound volumes . . . all available to every student.

RECREATION

At each student's disposal, is the fine modern gymnasium with swimming pool, and three athletic fields, as well as tennis, golf, archery, and many other forms of recreation.

COURSES AVAILABLE

Pacific University is a four-year Liberal Arts College and has a wide range of major departments including Biology, Pre-medicine, Chemistry, Economics, Business Administration, Education, English, History, Mathematics, Modern Languages, Physical Education, Philosophy, Physics, Music, Geology, Religion, Sociology, Speech, Dramatics and Home Economics.

Training courses for men and women.]

In addition to the above fields, Pacific is known throughout the Northwest for its Conservatory of Music in which students can receive training in Voice, Piano, Violin, Pipe Organ, Public School Music, and Conducting. The Conservatory gives a degree of Bachelor of Music.

ACCREDITATION

Pacific University is fully accredited in the United States as a four-year Liberal Arts College granting Bachelor degrees in Arts, Science, and Music. It is a charter member of the Northwest Association of Secondary and Higher Institutions. It is also a member of American Association of Church-Related Colleges.

COSTS

Expenses at Pacific University, exclusive of board and room, are as follows:
