LOCAL INPUT SOUGHT FOR DIALOGUE ON POVERTY

Poverty in Washington County? We may not like to admit it, but for over 62,000 men, women and children who live here, poverty is all too familiar. Basic needs which are taken for granted by the rest of Washington County - affordable housing, safe and healthy children, employment close to home - are big problems for 20% of county residents.

Added to the fact that local poverty is frequently unseen is the outdated perception of what living in poverty means. More and more, the chronically poor have been joined by people whose situations have suddenly thrust them into difficult circumstances. There has been a definite increase in the number of working poor families as well.

Community Action Organization invites the public to discuss these issues in its local Dialogue on Poverty forums. Open to all, these dialogues are an opportunity for residents of the county to share their experiences and to exchange ideas and information.
