About Pacific University

Pacific University was chosen by 350 G. I. men, and 20 G. I. women as their post-war college.

125 student families will be full-time members of the community for the duration of their term of schooling.

80 students plan to be teachers.

150 are Optometry and pre-medical students.

95 are majoring in education and physical education.

Majors are offered in twenty different fields of education.

Over 650 students are now regularly enrolled, and that next semester we will have over 700 on the campus.

Next year the total enrollment will approximate 1,000.

Our present enrollment of over 650 students will spend in the neighborhood of \$300,000 for living costs, over and above their tuition.

Pacific University makes purchases locally of \$100,000 worth of supplies per year.

Our cafeteria service alone spends \$7,000 per month for foods and supplies.

The cafeteria has the highest rating given a food dispensing service in the state.

Pacific University employs over fifty full-time staff members.

The payroll for its staff amount to approximately \$140,000 per year.

Most of the staff members live in Forest Grove, and many of them own homes and join in the total life of the community.
