the second part, witnesseth that the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the
sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS
to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold and
conveyed, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second
part, the following described premises, to-wit:
