## OVERVIEW OF MEETING:

MANAGEMENT OF IRANIAN OIL CUT-OFF SHORTAGE IS WITHIN THE RELATIVELY EASY ABILITY OF THIS COUNTRY. THIS SITUATION, HOWEVER, ONLY SHARPLY BRINGS INTO FOCUS THE TERRIBLE EXPOSURE OF THIS COUNTRY BY IT'S DEPENDENCE ON FOREIGN OIL ENERGY - GASOLINE OR ELECTRICITY. THE MEETING, IF THE MESSAGE IS CARRIED CLEARLY BY THE GOVERNORS AND THE MEDIA, MAY FINALLY GAIN THE PENETRATION OF BELIEF TO AMERICANS GENERALLY. THIS THEN MIGHT CONVERT INTO RESOLVE AMONG THE PEOPLE TO ACTION TO DO SOMETHING ABOUT IT.

HOWEVER, THE ADMINISTRATION SEEKS ONLY DEEPLY COMMITTED TO THE NECESSARY BUT SHORT-TERM ACTION OF CONSERVATION AND SOME CONVERSION OF ~~FREE~~ OIL FIRED UTILITIES TO COAL. THERE STILL DOES NOT SEEM TO BE ANY DEEP-SEATED DETERMINATION TO MOVE <sup>AS</sup> AGGRESSIVELY INTO OTHER SOURCES OF ENERGY - OIL SHALE, COAL & NUCLEAR. CONSERVATION CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED BY AMERICANS — IT WILL NOT SOLVE THE LONG-TERM PROBLEM AND EACH DAY WE WAIT WILL MAKE THAT SOLUTION ONE DAY FURTHER OUT INTO THE FUTURE (WE HAVE ALREADY LOST TOO MANY "ONE DAYS").

DECISIONS MUST BE MADE FOR OUR ECONOMIC FUTURE — WHICH MEANS ~~THE~~ THE FUTURE OF OUR FORM OF GOVERNMENT — IS REALLY AT STAKE. I FOUND NO SENSE OF URGENCY ABOUT THIS.

AS TO THE SITUATION IN IRAN, THE U.S. CUT-OFF OF OIL WAS PURE AND SIMPLY DONT TO TAKE AWAY A BARGAINING TOOL FROM THE IRANIANS. THE CONDITIONS ARE EXTREMELY GRAVE AND <sup>CONTINUED</sup> THE LIVES OF THE HOSTAGES ARE STILL IN DOUBT. OUR GOVERNMENT IS DELIBERATELY ACTING IN A RESTRAINED WAY — AS DIFFICULT AS THAT IS — TO DO EVERYTHING IN ITSELF POWER TO ASSURE THE

SAFE RETURN OF OUR CITIZENS. IT APPEARS TO ME THAT IRAN IS ALMOST IN A STATE OF ANARCHY — IF NOT THERE'S ALREADY. THIS MAKES OUR NEGOTIATIONS EVEN MORE DIFFICULT. INTERNATIONAL SYMPATHY IS WITH THIS COUNTRY, ALTHOUGH NOT OVER ACTIONS BY OUR FRIENDS HAS YET TO BE ENDORSED EXCEPT BY PUBLIC PRONONOUNCEMENTS. ALL OF MUST RESTRAIN OURSELVES AS MUCH AS HUMANLY POSSIBLE FOR AMERICANS TO BE RESTRAINED.

AND SO WE FIND THE MEETING CONTAINED TWO ELEMENTS. ONE BEING THE HOPE THAT RECOGNITION OF OUR LONG-TERM DANGER, IF WE DO NOTHING, OR LONG-TERM BENEFIT IF WE ACT AGGRESSIVELY.

AND TWO, WE MUST HELP OUR GOVERNMENT IN RETURNING OUR CITIZENS SAFELY.
