AN OLD SADDLE.—Mr C H Walker, son-in-law of Mr Jason Wheeler, gave an interesting talk Sunday on the early missionary work in the Northwest, which was full of historical interest. In this connection Mr Walker is fully competent to do so from his own experience. His parents, Rev Elkanah and Mary Walker, came to the Northwest in 1838, during which year Mr Walker was born near Fort Colville. They moved to Washington county in 1848, where Mrs Walker is now residing in Forest Grove, at an advanced age. She has in her possession now the saddle on which she crossed the plains 55 years ago. Mr Walker has been with the Warm Springs several years, and is a fluent talker in their language.
