### The Zen-Garden of Ryoanji Temple

Let us sit down quietly and contemplate this garden of sand and stones

Soami, the famous artist who created this garden, here expresses his understanding of Zen enlightenment with great simplicity, requiring neither words nor precepts to convey his limitless message.

We can view the garden as a group of mountainous islands in a great ocean, or as mountain tops rising above a sea of clouds. We can see it as a picture framed by the ancient mud wall, now in itself regarded as a national treasure, or we can forget the frame as we sense the truth of this sea stretching out boundlessly.

Soami's eloquence will apeal forever to those who will look at the garden with inner eyes. Absorbed in this scene, we, who think of ourselves as relative, are filled with serene wonder as we intuit Absolute Self, and our stained minds are purified.

In Zen, everything, even a leaf of grass, expresses ultimate Reality. Thus we can say that this simple garden of itself suggests to us absolute value.

This garden is such a profoundly meaningful one. Beyond any comparison with others of the world, that it might better be called, Mu-tei-"Garden of Nothingness," or Ku-tei-"Garden of Emptiness," than Seki-tei- "Garden of Stones."

#### **JISHO-JI(GINKAKU-JI)**

This temple was built in 1482 by the Shogun Yoshimasa Ashikaga as his villa. "Shogun" was a kind of general and held the real power of reigning over Japan in those days. After Yoshimasa's death, it was turned into a temple of the Zen sect according to his will. Although this temple is popularly known as "Ginkaku-ji", the real name is "Jisho-ji", It was named after the priest name of Yoshimasa.

#### Hondo (Main building)

Ginkaku (Silver Pavilion, National Treasure) In this two-storied building. The statue of Kannon, the Goddess of Mercy, is enshrined upstairs. The interior of the second floor is varnished with black lacqure. The original plan was to cover this building with silver leaf. though it was not carried out. One thousand statues of Jizo, the guardian god of children, is enshrined downstairs.

Togu-do (National Treasure) Yoshimasa's wooden image dressed as a monk is preserved here. In the inner part there is a small room for tea ceremony. From this started the typical tea ceremony room.

Garden This garden was designed by the famous garden designer "Soami". The sand mound in the center is named "Ginshadan" or the sea of silver sand. The shape was modeled after that of the west Lake in China. The furrows on the sand represent the ripples, on which the moonlight was meant to reflect and to brighten the garden at night. The samll sand hill of Mt.Fuji-shape is named "Kogetsudai". Shogun Yoshimasa enjoyed watching the moon here.

### NINOMARU PALACE National Treasure

This palace was originally built in 1603 by Ieyasu Tokugawa, the first Tokugawa Shogun, and was completed in 1626 by Iemitsu Tokugawa, the third Shogun, with some structures being transferred from a part of Fushimi Castle and with some decorations newly added. Consequently it is the quintessence of Momoyama architecture. It was used as the residence for successive Shoguns when they visited Kyoto.

As the fifteenth Shogun Yoshinobu Tokugawa returned the sovereignty to the Emperor in the year 1867, the castle was also transferred to the Imperial family. In 1884 it was named Nijo Detached Palace. In 1939 it was granted to Kyoto City since when it has been opened to the public.

The palace is a representative example of the Momoyama Period "Buke-fu Shointsukuri" mansion. This building of thirty-three rooms occupies 3,300 square meters and has about 800 tatami mats. The building material is mostly of Japanese cypress (hinoki).

All the sliding doors, walls and coffered ceilings are works of art having rich color paintings executed by artists of the Kano school. On door transoms are marvellous carvings.

To the north-east of the mansion there is a kitchen and service room building which has been designated culturally important.

## @@ OHIROMA ICHI-NO-MA, NI-NO-MA

The shogun granted audience to non-hereditary feudal lords in this room. As none of the four corners of the coffered ceiling are right-angled, it is called a "folded-up" coffered ceiling. The ceiling of the upper room, which is called First Grand Chamber, is double "folded-up". It has an alcove, shelves and a built-in desk. At the north of the room there is a room for body-guards. Ali the paintings in this room are works of Tanyu Kano. This is typical of the Buke-fu Shoin Tsukuri, or the warrior type 'SHOIN' room, built during the Momoyama Period.

This audience Chamber has historic significance. It was in this room that the last Shogun Yoshinobu Tokugawa announced to the feudal lords that he would return the sovereignty to the Emperor, thus abolishing the Shogunate goverment that had lasted for nearly 300 years.

### O OHIROMA SAN-NO-MA

This was the anteroom for visiting non hereditary feudal lords. Each of the carved panels on the transoms is made of one block of cypress wood.

The metals on the door-heads are called "Nail Covers of Hananoshi shape". They are made of copper, plated with gold. They are hand-made, and none of them are the same.

ingale Flooring, owing to its squeaking and

creaking whenever a person treads along it.



#### The coffered ceilings of every room have very gorgeous, colorful designs. The ceiling of corridors had originally been plain, but was painted after the Meiji Restoration of 1867.

### SHIROSHOIN

The innermost part of the building is named Shiroshoin. This was the living quarters of the Shogun. The paintings are by Koi Kano who is the teacher of Tanyu Kano. These modest paintings of mountains and rivers seem quite appropriate for a living room.



### O CHIROMA YON-NO-MA

It is said that spears and swords were kept in this room. The massive painting of a pine tree and a hawk by Tanyu Kano is appropriate to such a room.

### O WILLOW ROOM AND YOUNG PINE ROOM

These two rooms just inside the entrance hall are so named because of the paintings installed. These rooms were used by inspectors to identify visiting feudal lords.

In this room the minister of the Shogun received visiting feudal lords. Presents to the Shogun were also accepted here. Pictures on the wall were painted by Tanyu Kano when he was 25 years old.
