BASIC POINTS ON LEGISLATIVE TAX PACKAGE

Constitutional: (House Joint Resolution 8)

New tax base for schools (last year operational levy)  
plus 5%

Limited elections...two elections to exceed base in even-numbered years, two elections in odd-numbered year if school district did not exceed base the year before or one election if district did exceed base year before. In this latter event district must go for new base in Primary election, if that fails, then they can go to exceed.

Proceeds from a sales tax to be put into property tax relief account and distributed as an offset

Sales tax at 3% placed into Constitution

Legislature can reduce bases or increase bases of school districts, the latter only related to student population

Provides that corporation tax increase, senior citizen property tax "freeze" and "circuit breaker" for low income families (in homes and apartments), the school election dates and the sales tax will not go into effect unless HJR 8 passes

Election date June 3, 1969
