We will lay a wreath at the Forest Monument Plaque of Governor Tom McCall in whose honor the first Oregon Friendship Forest was dedicated in May 1973. Visit new forest and park areas and then stop at Safed, the ancient Holy City of the Galilee. Leave Galilee for Tel Aviv. Visit Tel Hazor ( site of Michener's Tel Makor in "The Source"), then to Mt. of Beatitudes (Sermon on the Mount), Capernaum, lunch at ancient Timberias on the Sea of Galilee. Stop at the Jordan River. Visit plywood plant at Afikim. Then to Tel Aviv. Visit with Mayor of Tel Aviv. Lunch at historic harbor of Jaffa. Afternoon for shopping or rest or visit to one of several outstanding museums and/or urban development projects. Leave early by coach for biblical Beersheva in the

Sinai. We will be accompanied by agricultural experts who will show experimental and working stations which are revolutionizing dry land farming, including drip irrigations techniques and soiless food growth projects and salt water irrigation techniques. Those who have seen these state they are truly outstanding. Lunch/ reception with Mayor Eliahu Navi of Beersheva. Return to Tel Aviv for farewell dinner.

Our Egypt schedule will be detailed later but will certainly include the Pyramids, National Museum of Archeology and tours of greater Cairo.

Depart Cairo. Those returning to Portland will go by way of London, then polar flight to Seattle and Portland. Those going to European destinations enroute home will go by seperate flights to complete their private itineraries.
